School Bus Driver Award

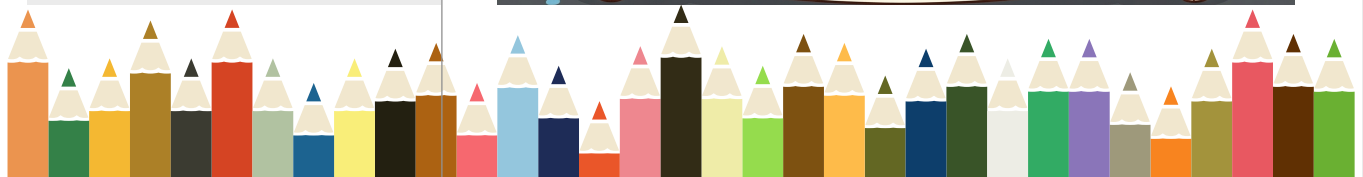
